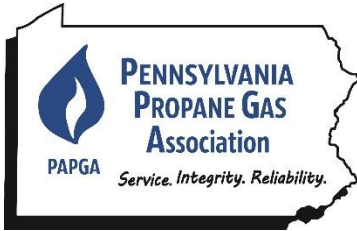

We pick up the annual service fee for PA One Call Systems, Inc. State law requires notification to PA One Call (Dial 811 or 800-242-1776) three (3) days prior to disturbing the earth with any type of powered equipment or ten (10) days working notice when in the design phase. After you call, you will receive an invoice then simply forward (mail or email) to PAPGA's office. Your membership will be verified and sent to PA One Call marked paid.
